Action Figure Kit Contents:

- Bendable blank action figure canvas
- Found objects and materials for decorating
- Registration Form

Materials You Will Need from Home:

- Markers, paint, or any mark-making instrument
- Scissors
- Glue and/or tape
- Found objects, recycled materials, scraps of fabric (optional)
